SUBJECT: 2007/08 CONCRETE PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS (GREEN HILLS DRIVE – RED OAK DRIVE TO UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD)

BACKGROUND:

This annual program is for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of concrete street sections that have deteriorated. This provides enhanced rideability and extends the service life of the street.

The 2007/08 program location is Green Hills Drive from Red Oak Drive to University Boulevard. This project will include an asphalt overlay on the existing concrete pavement to improve rideability and to correct cross-slope issues. A portion of Green Hills Drive from University Boulevard to west of the Gateway Hotel main entrance will be a crack and seat project with placement of an asphalt overlay. This process will increase the life of the overlay by decreasing the potential of reflective cracking.

Staff has completed plans and specifications with estimated construction costs of \$172,000. Engineering and construction administration costs are estimated at \$50,000. This project is shown in the 2007/08 approved budget with financing in the amount of \$300,000. Remaining funds will be used for additional projects.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. Approve the 2007/08 Concrete Pavement Improvements (Green Hills Drive Red Oak Drive to University Boulevard) by establishing April 16, 2008, as the date of letting and April 22, 2008, as the date for report of bids.
- 2. Reject the project.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

By approving the plans and specifications, it will be possible for construction to commence in order to improve the ride and extend the service life of the street.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby approving the 2007/08 Concrete Pavement Improvements (Green Hills Drive – Red Oak Drive to University Boulevard) by establishing April 16, 2008, as the date of letting and April 22, 2008, as the date for report of bids.
