SUBJECT: 2020/21 TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROGRAM (S. DUFF & S. 5TH STREET)

BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Signal Program is the annual program that provides for replacing older traffic signals and constructing new traffic signals in the City, which will result in improved visibility, reliability, and appearance of signals. This program provides upgrading of the traffic signal system technology. Traffic signal replacements include radar detection systems instead of in-pavement loop detection systems, providing detection of bicycles in addition to vehicles and much greater reliability. This project will install a new signal and one new pedestrian ramp at the intersection of S. Duff Avenue and S. 5th Street.
