**SUBJECT:** 2023/24 SHARED USE PATH SYSTEM EXPANSION

#### **BACKGROUND:**

This program provides for construction of shared use paths on street rights-of-way, adjacent to streets, and through greenbelts. The Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) identifies those paths that separate bicycle traffic from higher-speed automobile traffic. This project involves the extension of a shared use path along E. Lincoln Way from Carnegie Avenue to the SW corner of Dayton Avenue to eliminate the need for bicyclists and pedestrians to use the existing frontage road.

Staff has been working with Bolton & Menk of Ames, Iowa to develop plans and specifications for the project with a total estimated construction cost of \$306,813.50. The table below shows the revenues and expenses for this project:
