

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE AMES CITY COUNCIL

JUNE 2, 2010

The Ames City Council met in special session at 5:16 p.m. on the 2nd day of June 2010, in the Mahlstedt Center Conference Room at Reiman Gardens pursuant to law with Mayor Campbell presiding. The following Council members were present: Davis, Goodman, Larson, Orazem, and Wacha. Council Member Mahayni was absent. *Ex officio* Member England was also present.

5-DAY CLASS C LIQUOR LICENSE FOR OLDE MAIN BREWING COMPANY: Moved by Goodman, seconded by Larson, to approve a new 5-Day Class C Liquor License for Olde Main Brewing Company at The Octagon Center for the Arts, 427 Douglas Avenue.

Heather Johnson, 310 Topaz Court, Ames, identified herself as the Director of The Octagon. She advised that The Octagon formerly had been a liquor-licensed establishment, and they were unaware that the license had not been renewed or had expired.

Council Member Davis reminded the City Council that the Main Street Cultural District had to change its events when it did not have proper licensing.
