Please note as you review the attached request from the ISU Homecoming Committee, the requested start time for the display is 11:55 p.m. on October 19.

Organizers are aware of the City Council's preference that fireworks displays start before 10:00 p.m., and of the concerns expressed by members of the community about interruptions to sleep, particularly for young children.

In making this request, the Homecoming Committee will be limiting the show to approximately ten minutes and will be using ground-effect displays and no more than 2" shells. In addition, none of the "air bombs" (loud exploding sound only) will be used.

A Committee representative will be available at the City Council meeting on October 9th to answer questions.
