SUBJECT: 2006/07 COLLECTOR STREET REHABILITATION PROGRAM (24TH STREET)

BACKGROUND:

The annual Collector Street Rehabilitation Program is to restore structural integrity, serviceability, and ride-ability to collector streets. Identified in the 2006/07 program was 24th Street between Grand Avenue and Duff Avenue. This project included removing the existing seal coat pavement, reconstruction of storm sewer intakes, pedestrian ramp reconstruction, and placement of full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt pavement.

On July 11, 2006, City Council awarded the construction contract to Manatt's Inc. of Ames, Iowa in the amount of \$457,918.77. Construction was completed in the amount of \$441,310.35. Engineering and construction administration costs are in the amount of \$56,620. This brings total project costs to \$497,930.35.

This project is shown in the 2006/07 approved budget with financing in the amount of \$600,000 from General Obligation Bonds. The remainder of the funds will be utilized for additional projects.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. Accept the 2006/07 Collector Street Rehabilitation Program (24th Street/ Grand Avenue to Duff Avenue) as completed by Manatt's Inc. of Ames, IA, in the amount of \$441,310.35.
- 2. Direct staff to pursue modifications to the project.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby accepting the 2006/07 Collector Street Rehabilitation Program (24th Street/ Grand Avenue to Duff Avenue) as completed by Manatt's Inc. of Ames, IA, in the amount of \$441.310.35.
