SUBJECT: New Liquor License Application for Bali Satay House

The Council agenda for March 24, 2009, includes a new liquor license application for Bali Satay House. You approved a six-month license for the establishment after a renewal in which the police department identified several issues that needed to be addressed by management.

Since the temporary license was issued, our records show the following calls for service:

- Two citations for possession of alcohol underage 10-23-2008 and 11-22-2008
- One citation to an employee for selling alcohol to a minor during a police compliance check on December 5, 2008

Police calls for service to Bali Satay House for disturbances and fights have declined. The owner has also changed the entertainment format to limit shows that are likely to bring in participants who will participant in disorderly conduct or criminal behavior.

I have also been in contact with the owner to work on establishing a time when minors need be off the premises and food sales have ceased. Our discussion is continuing and we are working on the steps to complete this process.

Based on the recent history of cooperation with bar management and the reduction in requests for police services, the police department would support approval of this application.
