SUBJECT: FINAL COMPLETION OF WATER TREATMENT PLANT CLARIFIER PAINTING PROJECT

BACKGROUND:

On July 10, 2007, City Council awarded a contract to L&P Painting Company, Inc. in the amount of \$114,549.00 for repainting of the 70-foot and 84-foot clarifiers at the Water Treatment Plant.

All work under this contract was completed in accordance with the plans and specifications on April 22, 2009. Four change orders were issued for this project in order to complete the project as originally intended, reducing the final contract amount to \$111,810.98. A copy of the Engineer's Statement of Completion is attached.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Accept completion and authorize final payment, in accordance with the contract, to L&P Painting Company, Inc. for the painting of the two Water Treatment Plant clarifiers.
2. Do not accept completion of the Water Treatment Plant clarifier painting project at this time.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Work for the Water Treatment Plant Clarifier Painting Project has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications, and the project engineer has provided a Statement of Completion.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby accepting completion of this contract with L&P Painting Company, Inc.


