The Council agenda for October 13, 2009, includes beer permits and liquor license renewals for:

- Class C Liquor London Underground, 212 Main Street
- Class C Liquor & Outdoor Service Privilege Element/Chasers, 2401 Chamberlain
- Class C Liquor & Outdoor Service Privilege The Meeting House, 823 Wheeler, Ste. 4
- Class C Beer, B Wine Aldi, Inc. #48, 1301 Buckeye Avenue
- Class C Liquor- Thumbs, 2816 West Street
- Class C Beer, SnappysDelivers.Com, 200 Stanton Avenue Suite #103

A review of the Ames Police Department's records found no violations for the following establishments during the renewal period and would recommend renewal: London Underground, The Meeting House, SnappyDelivers.Com, and Thumbs.

The following businesses had a record of at least one violation:

- Aldi, Inc. #48 April 2009, Employee cited for sale to under age person during compliance check.
- Element/Chasers Chasers, one on premises under age. Element, five on premises, three fake I.D. citations, three possession alcohol under age, and one Nuisance Party violation.

Element and Chasers share a liquor license and operate separate bars. The police department has been in contact with the management reference the violations. The police department would recommend renewal at this time.
