The Council agenda for January 12, 2010, includes beer permits and liquor license renewals for:

- Class C Liquor - Sgt. Peppers, 116 Welch Avenue
- Class B Liquor - Quality Inn & Suites Starlite Village Conference, 2601 E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street
- Class C Liquor - Café Beau, 2504 Lincoln Way
- Class C Beer - Casey's General Store #2560, 3020 South Duff Avenue
- Class C Liquor w/Outdoor Service - Café Shi, 823 Wheeler Street, Suite #5
- Class A Liquor - American Legion Post #37, 225 Main Street
- Class B Native Wine – Coe's Floral and Gifts, 2619 Northridge Parkway

A review of the Ames Police Department's records found no violations for Quality Inn and Suites Starlite Village, Café Shi, The American Legion, or Coe's Floral and Gifts. The police department would recommend renewal.

A search of records for Sgt. Pepper's included 7 violations for on premises and two over occupancy violations in the past twelve months. Most of this activity occurred in the first half of the year and corrective action was taken by the establishment.

Café Beau had two violations for on premises. There were no other violations.

An employee of Casey's was cited during a police compliance check for selling alcoholic beverages to underage persons. This occurred on January 17, 2008. Since that time, Casey's has passed additional compliance checks.

In each of these cases, the police department would recommend renewal.
