The Council agenda for February 23, 2010, includes beer permits and liquor license renewals for:

- Class C Beer & B Wine - Gateway Expresse, 2400 University Blvd.
- Class E Liquor, C Beer, and B Wine - Wal-Mart Supercenter #4256, 534 South Duff Avenue
- Special Class C Liquor & Outdoor Service - Stomping Grounds, 303 Welch Ave. #101
- Class C Liquor - Twentieth Century Bowling, 505 South Duff Avenue
- Class C Beer - Almost Always Open, 419 Lincoln Way
- Class B Liquor - Holiday Inn Ames, 2609 University Boulevard

A review of the Ames Police Department's records found no violations for Gateway Expresse, Wal-Mart Supercenter, Stomping Grounds, Twentieth Century Bowling, or Holiday Inn Ames. The police department would recommend renewal.

A search of records for Almost Always Open showed one violation dated August 27, 2009. In this case, an employee was cited for selling alcohol to minors during a police compliance check. We are continuing to monitor compliance. The police department would recommend renewal.
