The Council agenda for March 2, 2010, includes beer permits and liquor license renewals for:

- Class A Liquor & Outdoor Service - Elk's Lodge #1626, 522 Douglas Avenue
- Class C Beer & B Wine - Swift Stop #5, 3218 Orion Street
- Class E Liquor, C Beer, & B Wine - Sam's Club #6568, 305 Airport Road
- Class C Liquor - Carlos O'Kelley's Mexican Café, 631 Lincoln Way
- Special Class C Liquor - Valentinos, 823 Wheeler Street Suite 1
- Special Class C Liquor - The Spice Thai Cuisine, 402 Main Street
- Class C Beer - Swift Stop #4, 1118 S. Duff Avenue
- Class C Liquor - Headliner's, 2430 Lincoln Way

A review of the Ames Police Department's records found no violations for Puerto Vallarta, Coldwater Golf Links, Elk's Lodge, Swift Stop #5, Sam's Club, Carlos O'Kelley's, Valentinos, The Spice, or Swift Stop #4 during the past twelve months. The police department would recommend renewal.

A search of records for Headliner's showed two violations during the past twelve months. On July 18, 2009, an employee was cited for dispensing alcoholic beverages after hours. On July 24, 2009, an employee was cited for selling alcohol to a minor. A second employee was cited for failure to prevent consumption by minors for the same incident. The police department is continuing to monitor compliance and would recommend renewal.
