SUBJECT: RESOURCE RECOVERY PLANT CONVEYOR BELT REPLACEMENT

BACKGROUND:

The C-7 conveyor belt at the Resource Recovery Plant was installed in 1995 as part of a plant renovation. Since that time, it has conveyed 500,000 tons of refuse derived fuel through the air classifier on its way to the City's Power Plant. This belt displayed signs of wear and was in need of replacement.

On August 25, 2009, Council awarded the replacement contract to Precision Industries of Omaha, Nebraska, in the amount of \$25,131.58. On February 23, 2010, Precision Industries completed this project.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Accept the Resource Recovery Plant's C-7 Conveyor Belt Replacement project as completed by Precision Industries of Omaha, Nebraska, in the amount of \$25,131.58.
2. Direct staff to pursue modifications to the project.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The project is now complete and final payment is due to the contractor.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby accepting the Resource Recovery Plant's C-7 Conveyor Belt Replacement project as completed by Precision Industries of Omaha, Nebraska, in the amount of \$25,131.58.
