The Council agenda for March 23, 2010, includes beer permits and liquor license renewals for:

- Class C Liquor - Café Northwest, 114 Des Moines Avenue
- Class C Beer and B Wine - Kum & Go #200, 4510 Mortensen
- Class C Liquor - Ge' Angelo's, 829 Wheeler Street Suite 9
- Class E Liquor, C Beer and B Wine - Wal-Mart Store #749, 3015 Grand Avenue
- Class E Liquor, C Beer, and B Wine – Campustown Liquor, 218 Welch Avenue Suite 3
- Class C Beer & B Wine - Kum & Go #227, 2108 Isaac Newton Drive

A review of the Ames Police Department's records found no violations for Café Northwest, Ge' Angelo's, Campustown Liquor, or Kum and Go #227 during the past twelve months. The police department would recommend renewal.

An employee of Kum and Go #200 was cited for selling alcohol to a minor during a police compliance check on April 9, 2009. An employee of Wal-Mart #749 was also cited for selling alcohol to a minor during a police compliance check on August 27, 2009. The police department is continuing to monitor compliance by both of these licensees and would recommend renewal of both licenses at this time.

Lucullan's was up for renewal on their Class C License, but have applied for a Special Class C License for beer and wine. They have no previous violations and the police department would recommend approval of the new license.
