## SUBJECT: 2009/10 & 2010/11 NEIGHBORHOOD CURB REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

## BACKGROUND:

This is the annual program for replacement of deteriorated curb and gutter in selected neighborhood areas. Areas to receive curb and gutter replacement are selected by comparing and prioritizing applications received from neighborhoods to a priority matrix that has been approved by City Council.

Deteriorated concrete curb and gutter will be removed and replaced along Marston Avenue from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 13<sup>th</sup> Street. The benefits will include improved aesthetics for the neighborhood and reduced infiltration into the subgrade, which will lower future street maintenance costs.

Staff has completed plans and specifications with estimated construction costs of \$131,500. Engineering and construction administration are estimated in the amount of \$13,000, bringing total estimated costs to \$144,500. The project is shown in both the 2009/10 & 2010/11 Capital Improvement Plans with financing established in the amounts of \$75,000 per year from the Road Use Tax Fund. Remaining funds will be utilized for design, contract administration, and contingencies on this project.

### ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. Approve the 2009/10 & 2010/11 Neighborhood Curb Replacement Program by establishing June 16, 2010, as the date of letting and June 22, 2010, as the date for report of bids.
- 2. Reject the project.

### MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

By proceeding with this program, the City Council will continue to strengthen and improve a local neighborhood by restoring public infrastructure in the Marston Avenue area.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby approving the 2009/10 & 2010/11 Neighborhood Curb Replacement Program by establishing June 16, 2010, as the date of letting and June 22, 2010, as the date for report of bids.
