SUBJECT: **AMENDMENT TO 2009-10 CONTRACT WITH CHILDSERVE**

BACKGROUND:

Following its 2009/10 budget deliberations, the City Council approved a contract with ChildServe for 2009/10 in the amount of \$12,950. This allocation was split between day care for infants (\$4,200) and day care for children (\$8,750). On June 11, 2010, staff received a communication from ChildServe that it is requesting a reallocation of \$3,000 from the funding for infant care to children's day care. This change is being requested due to higher than anticipated utilization for children between the ages of two and five. A number of children have moved from the infant classification (0-24 months) to the children's day care classification.

This request will not change the total allocation of \$12,950 from the City to ChildServe for the 2009-2010 fiscal year.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. The City Council may approve ChildServe's requested reallocation of \$3,000 from the funding for infant care to children's day care.
2. The City Council may deny approval of this request.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council approve ChildServe's requested reallocation of \$3,000 from the funding for infant care to children's day care.

Dear Sheila:

I am writing to request a change in the allocation for ASSET funds approved for day care services. City funds have been used as follows July 2009 through April 2010.

Service	\$ APPROVED	\$ SPENT	\$ Balance
Day Care-Infant	\$4,200	\$1199.70	\$3,000.30
Day Care-Children	\$8,750	\$8,750	\$ 0

We have experienced higher than anticipated utilization for children 2-5 years of age and lower than anticipated utilization for infants 0-24 months of age. As a result I am requesting that \$2,936.13 be reallocated from Day Care-Infant to Day Care-Children to assure that funds are available for the months of May and June 2010 for the children using the city ASSET funds. This does not change the total amount of funds requested and approved. We have expended the funds approved for Day Care-Children from the other ASSET funding agencies.

We have currently served 6 children July 2009 through April 2010 with ASSET Day Care fund to include 2 infants and 4 children. All of the children reside in Story County.
