<u>SUBJECT</u>: REQUESTS FROM THE MAIN STREET CULTURAL DISTRICT RELATING TO JULY SIDEWALK SALES

BACKGROUND:

The Main Street Cultural District (MSCD) is again hosting Sidewalk Sales on July 28, 29, and 30, 2011. In conjunction with this event, organizers are requesting suspension of parking regulations and enforcement for the Central Business District from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., July 28-30. The approximate estimated lost revenue to the Parking Fund from the waiver of enforcement is \$2,700.

In order to allow businesses to showcase merchandise outside their stores, a blanket Temporary Obstruction Permit and blanket Vending License have also been requested. The MSCD asks that the Vending License fee be waived.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. The City Council can approve the requests for Sidewalk Sales as requested by the Main Street Cultural District.
- 2. The City Council can deny these requests.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Sidewalk Sales are successful activities held twice each year in the MSCD. Since these events bring shoppers to the MSCD, these requests further the City Council's goals to continue to provide support for the MSCD and help to make it a vibrant area.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby approving the requests for July Sidewalk Sales.
