SUBJECT: ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FOR CANOPY AT 313 FIFTH STREET

BACKGROUND:

The owner of the building at 313 Fifth Street, Craig Marrs, has requested an encroachment permit to allow a canopy to occupy City right-of-way. This new canopy is part of the façade improvements through the Downtown façade grant program.

The proposed canopy is 144 square feet, and should not impair the operation of the road way.

The requirements of Section 22.3 of the *Municipal Code* have been met with the submittal of a hold-harmless agreement signed by the property owner, and a certificate of liability insurance coverage which protects the City in case of an accident. The fee for this permit was calculated at \$144, and the full amount has been received by the City Clerk's Office.

MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council adopt Alternative No. 1, thereby granting the encroachment permit for the canopy.
