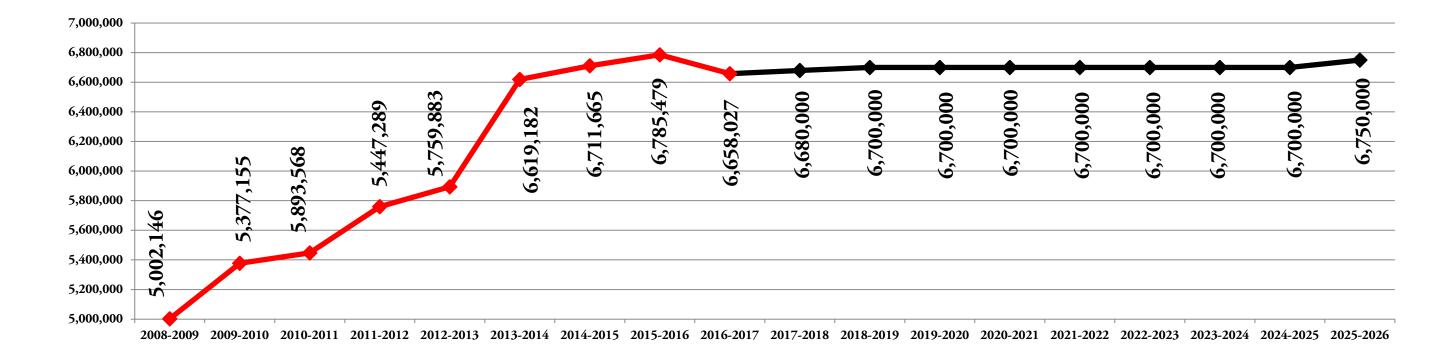

#### **Ridership History and Predicted Trend**

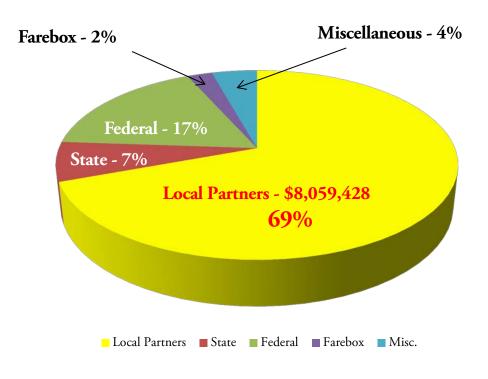




### TRANSIT OVERVIEW (p. 138)

- Total Budget: \$11.75 million
- **Revenues:** 
  - **Federal** No change
  - **State** No change  ${}^{\bullet}$
  - Fares "Rollback" of fare to 2011 to \$1/ride fare equivalent, instead of \$1.25 (current)
  - City
    - Increase 4.7% (Includes State Replacement Tax)
    - Total \$1,907,085 (Includes State Replacement Tax)
    - Transit Levy \$0.63361 per 1,000 valuation
  - Student Fee: Increased \$4.25 \$79.60/semester, full-time student









# TRANSIT OVERVIEW

#### • Expenses:

- **Fuel Cost Increase** \$2.75 per gallon (tax exempt)
- Health Insurance \$178,944 increase due to more employees being offered insurance and annual cost adjustments
- Payroll -
  - \$50,000 increase in overtime due to driver shortage
  - Initial driver wage increase from \$15.29 to \$15.60/hour (Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> Council Mtg.)
- Additional FTE: Part-time Information Technology employee
- **Service** Five additional hours of service per day (address service change issues and overcrowding)

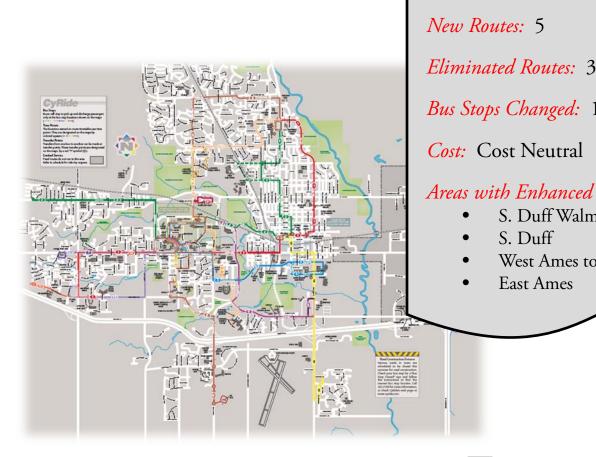
