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Hi Amber!

Sorry for the delay - I needed to dig up the Council Actions that were done on this topic in the past (August 2006) since it is not the first time it has been discussed by Council. Attached are documents presented to Council back in 2006. It is hard to capture just how unhappy some neighbors were to lose parking. So at the time Council felt that the speed warning signs were sufficient and that the parking may provide some traffic calming.

I would suggest, if we want to revisit the issue, we could poll the residents (by mailing) again to see where the majority of them stand (today) on that issue before making any changes.

Also, I pulled the most recent crash history (2009-2019), and there was only one reportable crash that was property damage only. It appears someone was driving too fast for snowy conditions. So, the data still does not support that there is an issue with the parked vehicles that are resulting in crashes. Though I am sure there may be plenty of close calls.

I copied the Clerk's and CM offices so they can also share this information with the rest of the Council.
