Subject: Requests from Kyle Poorman

At its April 27, 2021 meeting, City Council referred two requests from Kyle Poorman.

1. <u>Email from Kyle Poorman requesting a mixed-use trail extension along University Boulevard at the Iowa State University Recreation Complex</u>

As the South East Recreation Complex is Iowa State's property, the City of Ames does not have jurisdiction. Staff has forwarded the letter of request to appropriate Iowa State staff to further explore the request.

2. <u>Email from Kyle Poorman requesting the City to study crosswalk concerns on University Boulevard at South 16th Street.</u>

This intersection will be experiencing significant modifications with the 2024/25 South 16th Street Roadway Widening project in the CIP. It is anticipated that the roadway widening project will be constructing walks / paths on both sides of S. 16th Street up to the intersection of University Boulevard. At that time, the roadway project will include new pedestrian ramps to bring all 4 corners of this intersection into ADA compliance. Median alterations are also required to accommodate the improved pedestrian crossings and will be included in the roadway project.
