SUBJECT: 2020/21 MULTI-MODAL ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS (VET MED TRAIL – SOUTH 16TH STREET)

BACKGROUND:

This program improves roadways to create a safer interaction between various transportation modes using alternatives such as improved crossing visibility at intersections, bike detection, and on-street facilities (e.g., bike lanes, sharrows). **This project installed a new pedestrian hybrid beacon at the Vet Med Trail crossing of S. 16th Street.**

On June 8, 2021, City Council awarded the project to Voltmer, Inc. of Decorah, Iowa in the amount of \$66,436.66. One change order was approved by staff in the deduct amount of (\$344.97) to reflect final measured quantities, **bringing the final construction cost to \$66,091.69.**
