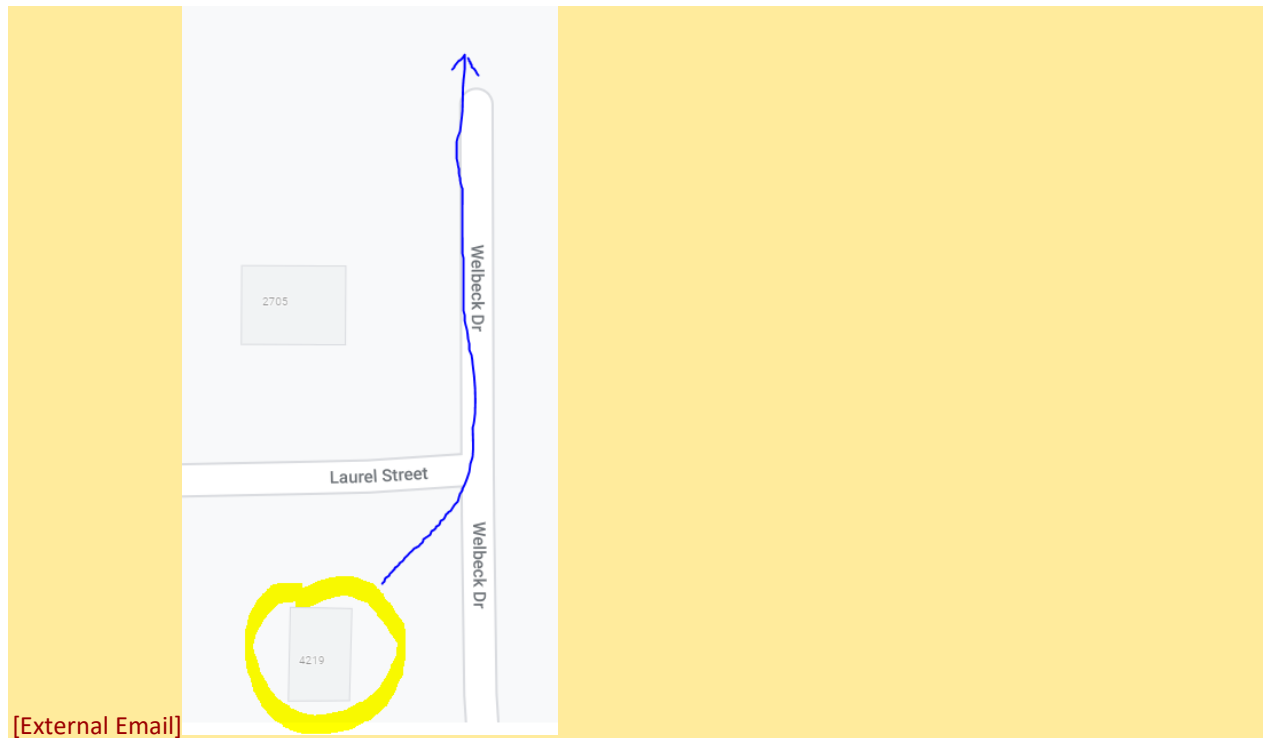

I am writing you about Sec 17.29 in the city code regarding snowmobiles and wanted to get your thoughts/opinion. We live at 4219 Welbeck Dr. on the north side of Ames. There is one house north of us, then a field. Whenever we get enough snow, we take our snowmobiles the short ½ block on the road to get to the field (have permission to be in there) to get us to the ditches on 190<sup>th</sup> St. I just happened to notice the city code does not allow snowmobiles on any public street, but there is a clause in there that states "...may be expressly authorized by the City Council". How would a person go about getting such permission and what are the chances of that actually happening for this short section of road that is really not used as it isn't a through street?
