This rather long but thought it would be of interest to all Ames RV owners. After finding out that the DOT closed the dump stations on I-35 I sent a note to Ames Pollution Control suggesting they update the dump station there along with redoing the plant, this is their response and my note back to them: Hello Jack, Calvin Forte from our Water Treatment Plant forwarded your email about the RV dump station to me. This has been something that we have talked through since we've heard about those closures at the DOT rest areas. The plans have already been finalized and bid for the facility upgrade and we did not elect to add new dumping facilities. We tracked our usage for a year and even with RAGBRAI coming through our usage has been minimal. Paving to the facility and a bridge upgrade would have to come through the county and would have considerable expense. In addition, our facility location is rather out of the way and isolated which is great for a wastewater plant but not convenient for RV dumping. As a matter of security we also try to limit exposure of the inside of the facility to outside folks when we are minimally staffed so that adds limits to the hours we can offer the service here. Internally we are looking at a couple small things we can do at our current dump station that could make it more convenient to use and hopeful that those may help people that choose to use it.

Please let me know if I can help address any additional thoughts or concerns with the facility.
