

2. Approve the requests, but do not allow the suspension of meter enforcement in Lots S and Q.
3. Do not approve the requests.

CITY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDED ACTION:

This event furthers the City Council's goal of promoting a sense of one community by facilitating an event in the Downtown district that provides a variety of entertainment, music, and resources for the community. The organization has a history of holding this event successfully in previous years.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the City Manager that the City Council approve Alternative #1 thereby 1) waiving the fee for the vendor license, 2) closing portions of Douglas and Kellogg as requested, 3) providing a blanket temporary obstruction permit, 4) waiving fees for parking in the event area, and 5) suspension of parking enforcement of Lots S and Q, pending receipt of \$184.50.
