## REZONE OF 921 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET (FORMER ROOSEVELT SCHOOL) FROM S-GA (GOVERNMENT/AIRPORT DISTRICT) TO UCRM (URBAN CORE RESIDENTIAL MEDIUM DENSITY)

Bob Kindred, Assistant City Manager, stated that at a recent Commission meeting staff reviewed the steps that need to be taken to enable the reuse of Roosevelt School as a residential structure. He stated that the zoning change for the property is before the Commission tonight. Mr. Kindred reviewed the current and proposed zoning for the property. He stated that the zoning for the ball field will not be changed due to the fact that the School District is finalizing the conveyance of that portion of the property to the City for use as a park.
